### **Transportation**

<u>Traveling from Don Muang International Airport to Suvarnabhumi International Airport</u>

ISTS will be providing <u>complimentary Shuttle Buses from Suvarnabhumi Airport to Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel)</u>. For attendees arriving at Don Muang International Airport who would like to use the ISTS Shuttle Bus to reach the ISTS42 Venue in Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel), you will need to arrange your own transportation to Suvarnabhumi International Airport. Provided below are four travel options.

### 1. Shuttle Vans

Vans from Don Muang Airport to Suvarnabhumi Airport with be located at a parking area outside of Terminal 1 (International Terminal). Take a right out of exit door 1 on level 1 of the International Terminal to reach the van parking area. Vans will be running from 03:00 am - 20:00 pm, taking 30 minutes to 1 hour to reach Suvarnabhumi Airport. The fare will be 50 THB ( $^{\sim}$ 1.40USD).

### 2. Public Bus

The public bus (number 555) will run from Don Muang Airport to Suvarnabhumi Public Transport Center between the hours of 06:00 am -24:00 am. The bus station is located in front of Don Muang Airport. Passengers can use the skywalk from Terminal 1 to Amari Hotel to reach the bus station. The fare will vary between 24-35 THB ( $\sim 0.67$ USD -1.00USD).

### 3. Taxi


There are three ways to travel from Don Muang to Suvarnabhumi Airport by taxi:

- 1. Taxi meters that are registered with the airport will be located at Terminal 1 (International Terminal) outside exit door 8 on level 1. Passengers need to take a queue coupon and pay an additional cost of 50 THB (~1.40USD).
- 2. Hailing a taxi from Vibhavadi road. The fare will vary from 300-400 THB ( $\sim$ 8.35 11.14 USD).
- 3. Using Grab Taxi. The fare will vary from 400-900 THB ( $^{\sim}11.14 25.00$  USD) depending on the travel time and the type of the car.

# 4. Bangkok Rail Transit Network

Take the RED line sky train from Don Muang International Airport to Bang Sue Grand Station then take the MRT (blue line) to Phetchaburi Station. From Phetchaburi Station, connect to the Airport rail link from Makkasan to Suvarnabhumi International Airport. The total travel fare will be 106 THB (~2.95USD).

### <u>Travel from Suvarnabhumi Airport to Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel)</u>

ISTS will be providing <u>complimentary Shuttle Buses from Suvarnabhumi</u>
<u>International Airport to the ISTS42 Venue in Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel)</u>
departing at 01:00am, 05:00am, 09:00am, 13:00pm, 17:00pm, and 21:00pm
each day on Saturday (23<sup>rd</sup>), Sunday(24<sup>th</sup>) and Monday(25<sup>th</sup>).

Information regarding the location of the ISTS Shuttle Bus at Suvarnabhumi International Airport will be provided at a later date.

## **Travel from Dusit Thani Hotel (Pattaya) to Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok)**

For departures from the ISTS42 Venue in Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel) to Suvarnabhumi International Airport, the ISTS Shuttle Bus will be providing rides departing at 01:00am, 05:00am, 09:00am, 13:00pm, 17:00pm, and 21:00pm each day on Friday(29<sup>th</sup>), Saturday(30<sup>th</sup>) and Sunday(31<sup>st</sup>). Additional shuttle buses may be added. The total travel time from Pattaya to Suvarnabhumi International Airport is approximately two hours. Please take this into consideration when planning your return trip home.

## <u>Travel from Bangkok to Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel)</u>

If you will <u>not</u> be using the complimentary Shuttle Bus provided by ISTS to the ISTS42 Venue in Pattaya (Dusit Thani Hotel), provided below are other options to reach Pattaya from Bangkok.

### **Rental Car**

There are many car rental sites and routes that can be taken to Pattaya from Bangkok.

- Bang Na Trad: Use Burapha Withi Expressway to Amata Nakorn then follow road signs for Pattaya.
- Bang Na Bang Pakong: Use highway number 34 Bang Na Bang Pakong then follow highway number 3 on Sukhumvit Road to reach Pattaya.
- Motorway Expressway (highway number 7): Use the motorway expressway and follow Chon Buri signs to reach Pattaya.

#### Taxi

There are two ways to travel from Bangkok to Pattaya by taxi:

- 1. Hailing a taxi. The fare will be about ~1,500 THB (~41.00 USD).
- 2. Using Grab Taxi. The fare will vary from 1,600-2,500 THB ( $\sim$ 45.00 69.00 USD) depending on the travel time and type of the car.

#### Van


Go to Ekamai Terminal or Mo Chit Terminal. The fare will vary from 120 - 150 THB ( $\sim 3.34 - 4.18$  USD) depending on your destination.

### Train

Take the train to Ban Plu Ta Luang or South Pattaya Station with travel expenses starting from 28 THB (~0.78 USD) depending on the type of train. Then use other public transport to reach your destination.

#### **Public Bus**

Buses to Pattaya will be available at Mochit 2 Bus Terminal and Ekamai Bus Terminal between the hours of 06:00 am - 20:00 pm for the price of 120 THB (~3.34 USD). The total travel time will be around 3 hours.
